



Having an infant, I look for events like this because we're new to the neighborhood and don't know many people yet. Without a vaccine available for my daughter, outdoor events like this are one of the few things we were able to attend and maintain distance, so it was a bummer when the music really threw a monkey wrench. We had to leave immediately, and we could hear the music about half a mile walking home down La Sierra from events at Arden Park. Please, keep the music! Live music is a real treat and a wonderful addition to events. Just set reasonable limits or require decibel checks prior to the performance so that the music doesn't cause undue damage to the ears of the visitors (including stimulation-sensitive kids and adults) and participants (including staff working the events having to be exposed to these levels of noise for hours) and so it's welcoming to the whole of the community.
