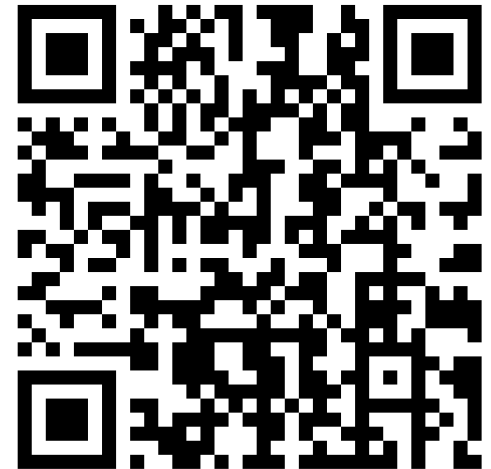

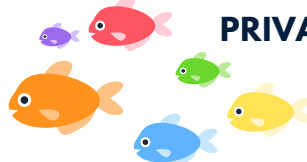

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

PARENT AND TOT (PT)	This class is for infants and toddlers between 6 months and 2 years with a parent in the water. Instruction focuses on familiarizing children with being in the water and includes fun and easy games.
WATER EXPLORATION (WE)	This is an introduction to water class. No previous water skills are required to enroll but swimmers should feel comfortable in the water with an instructor. Swimmers will learn to enjoy the water through songs and games, getting in/out of the pool safely, blowing bubbles, putting their face in the water, floating, and kicking.... all with instructor assistance.
PRIMARY SKILLS (PS)	Swimmers should be comfortable in the water and have experience putting their face underwater, floating, and kicking. Swimmers will learn how to practice front and back crawl arms, swim underwater two yards, and flutter kick with a kickboard five yards with assistance.
STROKE READINESS (SR)	This class is for swimmers who can swim freestyle 3 yards on their own. Swimmers will be working on correct stroke technique, kneeling dives, and swimming 5 yards unassisted freestyle and backstroke. At the completion of Stroke Readiness, swimmers should be able to swim half the length of a 25 yard pool without help.
STROKE DEVELOPMENT (SD)	Designed for swimmers who can swim half of a 25 yard pool on their own. Swimmers will be introduced to side breathing and working on flutter kick endurance, with the goal of swimming 25 yards. Swimmers will also be introduced to breaststroke and butterfly.

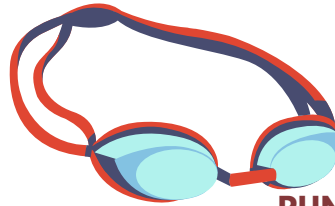
